Horatio Alger Scholarship: Students with a 2.0 GPA or above, have overcome adversity, are involved with extracurricular activities, & have a financial need are eligible to apply. Applications and information at [at Horatio Alger](#) and due **October 25, 2017.**

Washington University of St. Louis' Danforth Scholars Program: Applicants for this program must have a 3.8 GPA or above, SAT scores of 1150 or above/ACT score of 25 or above, and have already applied to the college by October 31. Prudential Spirit of Service Award: This is an award for community service and volunteerism. Local winners will compete nationally for a scholarship. Those who wish to be considered for the Tucker nomination should submit their community service logs, a one page essay on the most important volunteering opportunity they have had, and a resume to Mrs. Smith in School Counseling by **October 31, 2017.** ***Do not complete the online application until you have been notified if you are Tucker's nominee.**

Davidson' John M. Belk Scholarship: Applicants must have already applied to Davidson College in order to be considered for this nomination. Only 8 entering freshman will be given the full scholarship and considered Belk Scholars. Harry F. Byrd Jr. Leadership Award: Award winners receive \$10,000. Applicants should "demonstrate academic accomplishment and who also embodies excellence of character, leadership, and good citizenship." VCU Engineering Scholarship: Students who are pursuing an Advanced Diploma, have a 3.3 or higher GPA, SAT scores of 1130 or more, are in or have taken Calculus I or II, and have been accepted into the VCU School Of Engineering are eligible to apply for this scholarship. This can be worth up to \$10,000 per year.
